## Bible Verse

Luke 15:1-7

<sup>1</sup> Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. <sup>2</sup> But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, “This man welcomes sinners and eats with them.”

<sup>3</sup> Then Jesus told them this parable: <sup>4</sup> “Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders <sup>6</sup> and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbours together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.’ <sup>7</sup> I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

## Discussion Questions

1. How are you feeling? What emotions are you currently feeling? Share with those around you.
2. Where does it feel like the current is taking you?
3. If the serpent hears the voice of God, but chooses to ignore it, how can we be sure to avoid this lifestyle? How can we intentionally listen to Him?
4. How have you been listening to your shepherd’s voice?
5. Have you ever thought you were the one lost sheep? Are you trusting the father and choosing to find obedience in him?
6. The persecuted church in Central Asia recognise the cost of obedience, yet are ready to step out onto the water, as though it is solid ground. How can you have a similar obedience? Are you the 99 or the 1?
