Due to the civil war that began in 2015, at least 14 million people are at risk of famine in Yemen. In this environment, persecution and Islamic extremism has flourished. An estimated 85,000 children have died of malnutrition. Yemen is an Islamic and clan-based society. Converting to Christianity is seen as betraying one's clan and new believers are often disowned, forced into a Muslim marriage or killed.
