In Communist Vietnam, Christians are seen as dangerous and accused of betraying their culture. New believers have their rights stripped away and are often forced flee from their village to escape the violence. Some Christian children from an ethnic minority are not allowed to go to school because of their faith. Printing the Bible is restricted in Vietnam, making it hard to grow in faith. Any public expression of Christianity can lead to imprisonment.
