Christians experience persecution at all levels of society in Qatar. Christian converts from Islam are normally rejected by their family and community. Many conservative Islamic clerics advocate for conversion to be punishable by death. Sharing the gospel with Muslims is illegal and can lead to up to ten years in prison. Many Christians are forced to worship only in their homes or meet with believers in secret.
